

## MINNESOTA ROOFER APPRENTICESHIP TOOL LISTS

These are the initial tools that you must have when you begin the Roofer Apprenticeship Program:

- Insulation knife (keyhole or sheetrock saw)
- Tape Measure
- Retractable Utility Knife
- Hammer
- Flatbar
- Scissors
- Caulk gun
- Chalk Line
- Seam Roller
- Toolbox (prefer water-tight plastic toolbox)
- Tool pouches and belt

These are the tools you must have by either 3,500 work hours or 301, whichever comes first:

- Speed square
- Sump saw
- Cold Chisel
- Vice grips
- Allen wrenches
- Small ratchet wrench set
- Corner Roller
- Torpedo Level
- Trowel

These are the tools you must have by either 1,750 work hours or 201, whichever comes first:

- Screwdrivers
- Nut drivers (1/4", 5/16", 3/8")
- Crescent wrench
- Vice grips
- Tin snips
- Small ratchet wrench set including ½" and 9/16" deep well sockets

These are the tools you must have by either 5,250 work hours or 401, whichever comes first:

- Right snips
- Left snips
- Straight snips
- Hand folder
- Scratch-all
- Rivet gun
